REGIONAL CHALLENGES

- North Africa serves as a natural interface between Europe and Africa. It is currently undergoing structural transformations, exacerbated by the multifaceted crisis induced by the pandemic and geopolitical crises in Ukraine and the Middle East.
- As the Mediterranean facade of the continent, North Africa faces common climatic, social, and territorial challenges shared with the countries of the northern Mediterranean shore.
- The region is a historical crossroads of civilizations, deeply connected to the rest of the world.
 Expertise sharing and knowledge production are harnessed to fuel public policy dialogues and operations. These insights contribute to finding partnership-based solutions to address challenges on a regional scale.


