

Building Bridges through AI: Fostering India-Africa-France Dialogue to Advance AI for the Common Good

AI Impact Summit 2026 Pre-event hosted by the AFD Group at its Paris Headquarters

28 January 2026 - 9 AM to 1 PM



This pre-event aims to reinforce India-Africa-France cooperation on AI, support the Economic Growth & Social Good Working Group ahead of the Summit, and showcase concrete AI for development solutions in preparation for New Delhi.

Context

The [AI Impact Summit 2026](#), to be held in **New Delhi, India**, will highlight the tangible impacts of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and its transformative potential, particularly for emerging countries. The Summit is structured around three key priorities or *sutras*: **“People: Human-Centric AI”**, **“Planet: Environmental Responsibility”**, and **“Progress: Equitable Growth”**. These principles are embodied in seven *chakras*-pillars of international cooperation - designed to operationalize these priorities: **Safe and Trusted AI, Human Capital, Science, Resilience, Innovation and Efficiency, Inclusion for Social Empowerment, Democratizing AI Resources, and Economic Growth and Social Good.**

The Summit follows the [AI Action Summit held in Paris](#) (6-11 February 2025), in which the **AFD Group** played an active role given its strong engagement in AI cooperation with Global South countries. On that occasion, AFD co-organized, alongside the **Ministry of Digital Economy and Digital Transformation of Togo** and the **French Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs (MEAE)**, a high-level event entitled *“AI for Development: Solutions for a Sustainable and Inclusive Future”* held on 11 February 2025, as part of the Summit's side events.

These discussions build on growing Euro-African momentum, illustrated by two recent milestones: the [Global AI Summit on Africa](#) held in Kigali in April 2025, and the second [Mediterranean Forum on Artificial Intelligence \(FMIA\)](#) organized in Tunis in November 2025. Both events contributed to strengthening a shared vision, partnerships, and concrete cooperation on responsible AI across the continents.

AI Summit Pre-Event in Paris

Building on the AFD Group's cooperation with several African countries on AI, India's ambition to strengthen its partnerships in Africa, and France's upcoming organisation of the **Africa-France Summit** in Nairobi - where AI will be a key theme - a **dedicated pre-event** is proposed in Paris ahead of the AI Impact Summit.

Objectives

This pre-event will serve to align perspectives and prepare the *Economic Growth & Social Good Working Group* for the New Delhi Summit, which will focus on AI as a driver for achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). This event aims to:

- Foster dialogue between continents
- Showcase French initiatives on AI for development
- Facilitate alignment among key stakeholders on priority AI-for-SDG themes
- Highlight specific needs and solutions from Africa and India
